

WAIVER OF PROTEST OF ANNEXATION – CORPORATION

The undersigned, being a duly authorized official of the owner of the real estate hereinafter described, for and in consideration of the City of Evansville, Indiana, granting to the undersigned the right to tap into and connect to the sewer system of the City of Evansville for the purpose of providing sewer service to the described real estate, now releases the right of the undersigned owner of the described real estate and their successors in title to remonstrate against any pending or future annexation by the City of Evansville, Indiana, of such described real estate.

The waiver of rights associated herewith shall be a covenant running with the land and shall be binding upon the heirs, transferees, successors and assigns of the undersigned owner.
